Dear Madam / Dear Sir,

There has been a discussion within the Finnish Energy Industries concerning the POMPE report that was published in spring 2007. The report deals with transmission congestion management and it has been prepared through extensive co-operation between the regulator, the transmission system operator, energy industries and businesses in Sweden. The report presents solutions for congestion management methods to be used in the Nordic electricity market.

We believe that a major part of the problems in congestion management that have been disturbing the good functioning of the Nordic electricity market will be solved when the five big grid investments agreed by the Nordic TSO's have been realized. It is very important that the investment plan will be implemented rapidly and forcefully. Due to the central position of Sweden in the Nordic electricity market the importance of the so called South link is most essential. The Nordic electricity market needs a transitional solution for the time before the investments and a more permanent solution for the time after the investments.
